2020-21 Performance Targets Met: K-3 students as whole in the district did not meet any of our performance targets, but we did have specific schools meet the target: Rigby Virtual Academy met the IRI target in Kindergarten (91%), 1st grade (85%), and 2nd grade (83%). Harwood Elementary met the IRI target at 1st grade (83%) and 2nd grade (80%). Jefferson Elementary met the IRI target at 3rd grade (86%). Roberts Elementary met the IRI target at 1st grade (88%) and 3rd grade (86%). Planned Strategies to Address Areas of Challenge: For elementary literacy we now have 2 instructional coaches instead of 1 so we can help the schools and grade levels that did not meet the IRI target by replicating what has worked in the other schools and grade levels throughout the district. We have also set specific 3-5 ISAT goals that we will address by implementing the SICA in December and changing our end of chapter tests to be in IAB format for reading and math. 2020-21 Performance Targets Met: At the secondary level, high school freshmen and sophomores improved significantly in math and ELA per results on the ISAT 2018-2019, which was the last time students tested. In May of 2019 9th graders achieved 46% proficient in ELA and 24% proficient in math. In May 2021 9th graders achieved 60% proficient in ELA and 49% proficient in math. In May of 2019 10th graders were 47% proficient in ELA and 26% proficient in math. In May of 2021 10th graders achieved 61% proficient in ELA and 41% proficient in math. Areas of Challenge: In grades 6-8 math performance decreased. In grades 6-7 ELA performance decreased. Plans to Address Challenges: The math instructional coach and the ELA instructional coach will be working with middle grades teachers to identify areas of weakness students demonstrate in essential standards and to develop instructional strategies and formative assessments to measure students skills throughout the year. Instructional coaches will work with teachers to develop interventions to improve student learning. Also, we hope to
