2021-22 Performance Targets Met: K-3 students as whole in the district did not meet any of our performance targets, but we did have specific schools meet the target: Rigby Virtual Academy met the IRI target in Kindergarten (91\%), 1st grade (85\%), and 2nd grade (83\%). Harwood Elementary met the IRI target at 1st grade ( $83 \%$ ) and 2nd grade ( $80 \%$ ). Jefferson Elementary met the IRI target at 3rd grade ( $86 \%$ ). Roberts Elementary met the IRI target at 1st grade ( $88 \%$ ) and 3rd grade ( $86 \%$ ). Planned Strategies to Address Areas of Challenge: For elementary literacy we now have $\mathbf{2}$ instructional coaches instead of 1 so we can help the schools and grade levels that did not meet the IRI target by replicating what has worked in the other schools and grade levels throughout the district. We have also set specific 3-5 ISAT goals that we will address by implementing the SICA in December and changing our end of chapter tests to be in IAB format for reading and math.

2021-2022 Performance Targets Met: At the secondary level on the ELA ISAT assessment, all grade level proficiency scores improved from the previous school year. Some improvements came about because of a one percent increase in proficiency. This was the case in sixth grade, which went from $56 \%$ to $57 \%$ proficient. Eighth grade showed the largest increase from $\mathbf{5 5 \%}$ proficient in $\mathbf{2 0 2 1}$ to $\mathbf{6 8 \%}$ proficient in $\mathbf{2 0 2 2}$. When looking at cohorts of students to see how the same group improved from one year to the next, (i.e., 6th grade scores in 2021 compared to 7 th grade scores in 2022), improvements were more significant. The lowest cohort score was an improvement of $6 \%$ and the high was $10 \%$. On the math ISAT, students showed gains in grades $6,7,8$ and 10 . The greatest increase occurred at 10th grade, which showed $46 \%$ proficient, which was up from $34 \%$ proficient the previous year. The high percentages of proficient students were at grades 7 and 8 , with both grade levels iachieving $53 \%$ proficient. Areas of Challenge: The 9th grade math scores showed a decrease from $50 \%$ proficient in 2021 to $46 \%$ proficient in 2022. Plans to Address Challenges: The math instructional coach is meeting with high school teachers to help them implement interventions. Teachers will take data from their common formative assessments and create intervention plans for supporting students. The coach will be in classrooms of new teachers at least once per week to help improve teaching the curriculum with fidelity.
