2024-2025 Performance Targets: We did not meet our lofty goals, however we saw year over year growth in 1st through 5 grade targets. This is an indicator the the plan we put in place last year is working. We will continue with the the implmentation of of the new ELA curriculums : 95% Core Phones and Wonders, as teachers continue to implement the strategies within these curricula we feel our progress will continue and we will reach our goals. 6th grade performance target was met as we exceed our goal of 57% in ELA ISAT testing. While our 7-8 and 11 grade targets were not met, we are encouraged by our growth and our consistant performance among the top large school districts in the state. We continue our Rigorous Curriculum Design and allignment of unit assessments among grade level teachers. We are utilizing Performance Matters more effectively to analyze data, and training was provided to all staff on the effective utilization of PLC meetings and collaborative teaching and data analysis. While as a district we did not meet some of our goals, in each goal area we have individual schools meet the performance targets, through collaboration and cross school PLC meetings we are leveraging those strategies that are most effective and working to mirror that success in our all our schools.
