EDUCATION TRACK

Tutoring Practicum I – Open to 10, 11, 12 Repeatable course

Requirement filled: Elective
Prerequisite: Excellent attendance record. 2.5 GPA. No major discipline issues. Open to those who did not lose credit due to absenteeism in the previous trimester.
Content: This hands-on course provides an opportunity for RHS students to work with elementary school children tutoring in reading, writing and other areas under the supervision of the classroom teacher. Students are transported to and from local elementary schools by district bus. Consistent attendance in hour 1 is required. Students receive one elective credit per trimester

Teacher Aide – Open to 11, 12 Repeatable course

Requirement filled: Elective
Prerequisite: 3.0 GPA, Teacher written approval, and have passed the teacher's course with a 70%
Content: Consists of, but not limited to, assisting teachers with managerial and tutoring tasks.

Gen Ed 101 1 CSI cr. Open to 11,12

Requirement filled: Elective
Associate Requirement: Elective
Prerequisite: NA
Fee: May be Covered by Advanced Opportunities when student requests funding
Content: This course introduces students to the General Education Program at the College of Southern Idaho. Students will understand how general education supports the mission of the College; enhances degree programs; enriches understanding of the self, society, and the natural world; provides a basis for inquiry, expression, and problem-solving; and contributes to lifelong learning and wellness. Students will be introduced to strategies fundamental to college success. **Students are encouraged to complete this class within their first 15 credits.**

EDUC 201: Foundations of Education 3 CSI cr. Open to 10,11,12

Requirement filled: Elective
Associate Requirement: Elective
Prerequisite:
Fee: May be Covered by Advanced Opportunities when student requests funding
Content: This course introduces social, philosophical, and historical perspectives in education. Students will examine the teaching field, current trends, and teaching as a profession. (This class includes portfolio entry: autobiographical essay. Fulfills Idaho Core Teacher 6 and 9).

EDUC 202: Field Experience 1 CSI cr. Open to 10,11,12

Requirement filled: Elective
Associate Requirement: Elective
Prerequisite:
Fee: May be covered by Advanced Opportunities when student requests funding
Content: This course provides students with practical experience in K-12 classrooms and weekly discussions regarding professionalism in teaching. Under the supervision of a cooperating teacher, students will complete 30 hours observing and aiding their mentor teacher. (This course addresses Idaho Core Teacher Standards 1). Background Check required.

EDUC 205: Development and Individual Differences 3 CSI cr. Open to 10,11,12

Requirement filled: Elective
Associate Requirement: Elective
Prerequisite: EDUC201, or by teacher recommendation
Fee: May be covered by Advanced Opportunities when student requests funding
Content: This course examines the areas of exceptionality as identified in the laws and policies related to individualized education and considered as a basis for reflecting on human development/individual differences and diversity in the school. This course includes a case study that requires observation. Fulfills Idaho Core Teacher Standards 2, 6, and 9. A background check is required.

EDUC 215: Educational Technology 3 CSI cr. Open to 11,12

Requirement filled: Elective
Associate Requirement: Elective
Prerequisite: EDUC, 201,202
Fee: May be covered by Advanced Opportunities when student requests funding
Content: This course is designed to give students hands-on experience integrating technology into the curriculum. Students will engage in a wide range of activities and projects resulting in a practical understanding that teaching concepts and skills require expertise in various instructional methods and strategies. This course emphasizes the International Society for Technology in Education Standards (ISTE) 1, 2 and 3 and Idaho Core Teacher Standard (ICTS) 3, 5 and 8.

EDUC 290: Educational Technology Exit Seminar 1 CSI cr. Open to 12

Requirement filled: Elective
Associate Requirement: Elective
Prerequisite: EDUC; 201,202
Fee: May be covered by Advanced Opportunities when student requests funding
Content: This is the capstone course in the Teacher Education Program. Students will complete a professional outcomes portfolio. Students will be introduced to representatives from Idaho institutions and encouraged to complete application materials for their institution of choice. Fulfills Idaho Core Teacher Standards 1, 2, 6, 9, & 10
